Optical Outreach Training in The Gambia

The Gambia is Africa's smallest nation. It is surrounded by Senegal on three sides and the Atlantic on the west. Ninety-five percent of the people are Muslims.

In September, AGWM missionaries Scott and LaVonna Ennis hosted a CompassionLink Optical Outreach Training team in The Gambia. The goal of the training was to equip nationals to conduct optical outreaches. These outreaches provide opportunities for believers to share the love of Christ in practical ways by sitting face-to-face with non-believers.

During the training, ten students from the Al-Masih Worship and Training Center in Banjul, Gambia, were trained. The students were divided into teams of two and began putting into practice what they had learned. At the end of the week, **the teams had conducted optical screenings on 271 people.** Most of them received a pair of glasses and welcomed the opportunity to pray with the students. Only one person refused prayer, while the rest expressed their appreciation for the care and blessings they received from the team.

We feel incredibly fortunate to have received training from and partnered with Teach to Transform, an organization that provides basic medical training to pastors and evangelists in various countries around the world.
